2. River Cauvery :

It originates at Talacauvery in Kodagu districts of Karnataka. About 416KM of its course falls in Tamil Nadu. It serves as the boundary between Karnataka and Tamilnadu for a distance of 64km. It forms Hogenakkal waterfall in Dharampuri district and Mettur Dam in Salem district The Grand Anaicut also called as Kallanai was built across the river Cauvery. The network of distributaries within the delta of Cauvery in the coast is called as the Garden of Southern India. It merges into Bay of Bengal to the South of Cuddalore.
